## ***Disability Pride Day, Saturday, June 16, Noon to 3:00 PM***

The disability community - people with disabilities and their allies - will gather at the Humunity Center Muskegon on Saturday, June 16 to celebrate Disability Pride Day. This is an opportunity to educate ourselves and others about relevant and pressing issues and to demonstrate that our voices are critical to current policy debates. Over 26,475 residents in Muskegon County are people with disabilities under the age of 65. This is an opportunity to come together, learn more about each other, and build community.

All are welcome and encouraged to attend. Music, light refreshments, and speeches from local disability rights advocates, our allies, and elected officials will be provided. The program will also feature an "open mic" session to increase dialogue about disability issues in our community.

This event is supported by Disability Justice League West Michigan, Disability Network West Michigan, the Humunity Center, and Peer Action Alliance.

The Humunity Center is located at Our Savior Lutheran Church: 1132 W. Southern Avenue. The event is scheduled from 12:00 – 3:00 p.m. and is free of charge and open to the public.

## ***Synod Assembly—What's that?.***

A Synod Assembly is the yearly meeting of our nearest partners in ministry, which gives us a chance to worship together and get to know each other and the ministries we do together. This year's Synod Assembly was an especially joyful time of visioning the future of the church as we hosted Presiding Bishop of the ELCA, Elizabeth Eaton. Our Synod Bishop described Bishop Eaton as "the first among equals" when talking about the bishops of the ELCA.

The ELCA is not hierarchical as are many mainline denominations. We have three expressions of the church and all partner equally together in ministry. The three expressions are the 1,000 congregations, the 65 synods, and the churchwide ELCA. There are approximately 3.5 million members of the ELCA. When you join a local congregation, such as Our Savior's, you become a member of your Synod and the ELCA. We are all partners in ministry with each other. To read this year's
